

AIM SENIOR SECONDARY COLLEGE - What will you study?

YEAR 11 UNITS (12 credit points/3 terms)

In Year 11, you'll become familiar with the course structure, skills and content required to complete your HSC.

Foundation (compulsory) subjects:

- **Music 1 or 2**
- **English Advanced (NESA)**

Plus four NESA subjects chosen from:

YEAR 12 – HIGHER SCHOOL CERTIFICATE (10 credit points/3 terms)

Continue studying your foundation (compulsory) subjects, as well as three of the four additional subjects you chose for Year 11 to complete your HSC.

You'll receive study periods to prepare for your final assessments, and opportunities to perform in end-of-term musical productions, showcases and presentation ceremonies.

Currently, students can choose from two streams:

- 1. Music Performance (Classical or Contemporary)**
- 2. Music Technology**

This course runs in Year 11 (Terms 1, 2 and 3), and in the first term of study in the HSC year (Term 4).

Students undertake Year 11 and a Higher School Certificate (HSC) year - Year 12. In the initial year - Year 11, students become familiar with the course structure, skills and content required to complete the HSC. Mornings are spent teaching NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA) subjects and afternoons are focused on Industry Workshops, Masterclasses and AIM's 10 week Short Courses, offered in a variety of music and creative arts-focused areas.

Year 12 Higher School Certificate (HSC)

Students continue the foundation (compulsory) subjects in addition to three of the four subjects they chose for Year 11 to complete their HSC. They receive study periods to prepare for final assessments, and receive opportunities to perform in end-of-term musical productions, showcases and presentation ceremonies.

Student Outcomes

The HSC is the highest educational award in NSW schools. It is awarded to students who successfully complete Years 11 and 12 in NSW. The HSC is an internationally-recognised credential that provides a foundation for entering tertiary study, vocational training or employment. The academic courses at our SSC follow the NESA syllabus, and the outcomes gained are:

Year 11 outcome is the Completion of Year 11 Preliminary Course Certificate.

Year 12 Outcomes:

- Higher School Certificate (HSC)
- Exemption for auditions for AIM Tertiary degrees
- Eligibility for early acceptance into one of AIM's tertiary degrees
- Eligibility to enter other Australian University programs
